- Dalila Loudyi is a professor at the Water and Environmental engineering department at Hassan II University of Casablanca (UH2C) - Faculty of Science and Technology (FSTM) since 1996. She holds an engineering degree and a PhD. in environmental water management from the civil engineering department at Cardiff School of Engineering, UK. Pr. Loudyi's main research interests focus on water systems, flood risk assessment and management and climate change impact on water resources.
- In 2011, Pr. Loudyi was selected by the US. State Department as a candidate for Techwomen 2011 program that empowers, connects and supports women leaders in science, technology, engineering and mathematics (STEM) from Africa, Asia and Middle East. She is also active in civil society, in particular in the field of the defense of women's human rights. In this regard, since 2014, she has been a member of the board of the Democratic Association of Moroccan Women (ADFM), a national NGO which has been campaigning for the political, civic, socio-economic and environmental rights of women since 1985. She has since 2019 become the president of the ADFM-Casablanca. She was also a member of the steering committee of the TARGET Project on 'Taking a Reflexive approach to Gender Equality for institutional Transformation' funded under the European Horizon 2020 program for the period 2017-2021.
